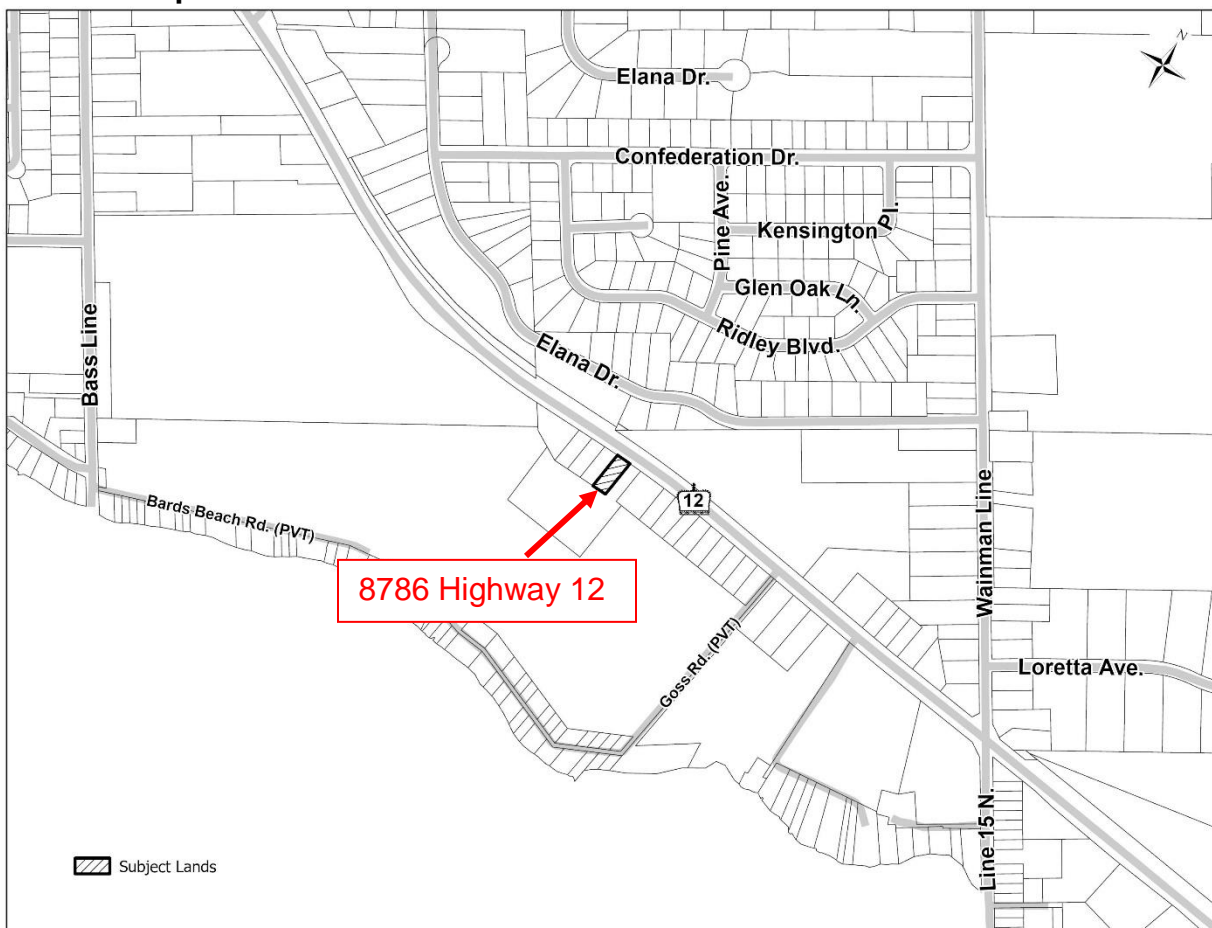
Section 5.4 – Apartment Dwelling Units Accessory to a Single Detached Dwelling
