



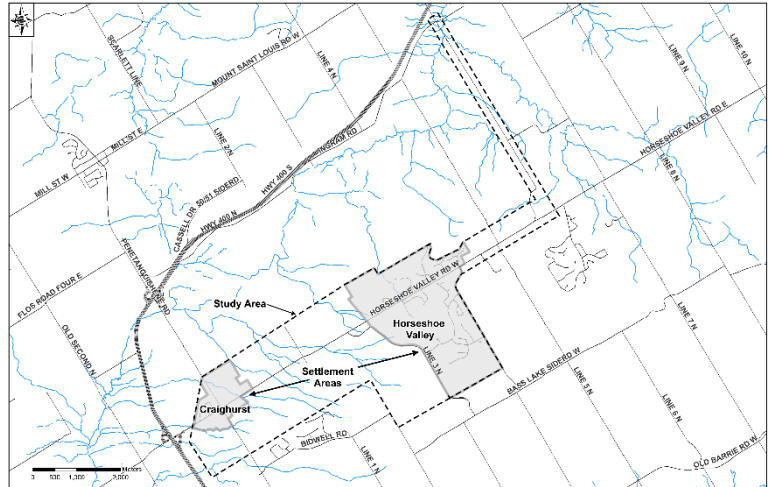

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

Horseshoe Craighurst Corridor Water, Wastewater and Transportation Master Plan

The Horseshoe Craighurst Corridor (HCC) Landowners Group Inc. (the "Landowners") and the Township of Oro-Medonte are undertaking a Water, Wastewater and Transportation Master Plan to identify a long-term servicing plan for the future development of the Craighurst and Horseshoe Valley settlement areas and adjacent lands (see map). The study area has been expanded and new proposed servicing infrastructure will be located within this study area to service future development in the two settlement areas.

The study is following the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Master Planning process Approach #2, as outlined in the MEA Class EA (October 2000, as amended October 2007, 2011 & 2015) document. The Master Plan will carry out the requirements for Schedule A, A+ and B projects, and set the stage for future Schedule C projects. The study will define existing problems and opportunities, and consider and evaluate alternative solutions to ultimately identify the preferred water, wastewater and transportation servicing strategy.



Public Consultation

Public and agency consultation is vital to the success of this study. To ensure that those interested in this project have an opportunity to provide input to and receive feedback from the study team, a Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held as per the details below. The PIC will present study background information, the various servicing solutions considered, evaluation of the servicing solutions and selection of the recommended servicing solutions and next steps.

Notice of Public Information Centre Backgrounder (regarding Horseshoe Craighurst Corridor Water, Wastewater and Transportation Master Plan)

Cole Engineering Group Ltd., the consulting firm for the Horseshoe Craighurst landowners' consortium, has advised the Township that the preliminary findings of the Horseshoe Craighurst Corridor Master Plan ("Master Plan") will be shared in a Public Information Centre (PIC) on January 23, 2019 at 6 pm at Horseshoe Centre, 1101 Horseshoe Valley Road.

This initial consultation is an important opportunity for the community to understand the preliminary findings from the Master Plan and provide input. The PIC has been initiated and organized by Cole Engineering Group Ltd., on behalf of the Horseshoe Craighurst Corridor Landowners. The Township encourages those who are interested, to attend the PIC, review the preliminary findings, and discuss the project with representatives from Cole Engineering. Written comments are also invited for further consideration and incorporation into the project record.

Pending the conclusion of the PIC, the consultants will consider input prior to finalizing and submitting a report to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, who will make the report available for public review for a period of 30 days.

The notice for the PIC has been promoted by Cole Engineering through local print media advertising, direct mail to project mailing list registrants as well as posted electronically. The Township has also shared the notice through its website, social media channels and directly with the local property owners' association.

Undertaking a comprehensive Master Plan of this scale is an important component of the development process for the Horseshoe Valley Craighurst corridor. The final results will identify short and long term strategies for water, wastewater and transportation to accommodate future growth as identified in the Township's Official Plan.

The Township is one of many project stakeholders. Over the course of the last three years, the Township has championed the completion of this important study which will present options and recommendations. We look forward to the meeting on January 23rd.
