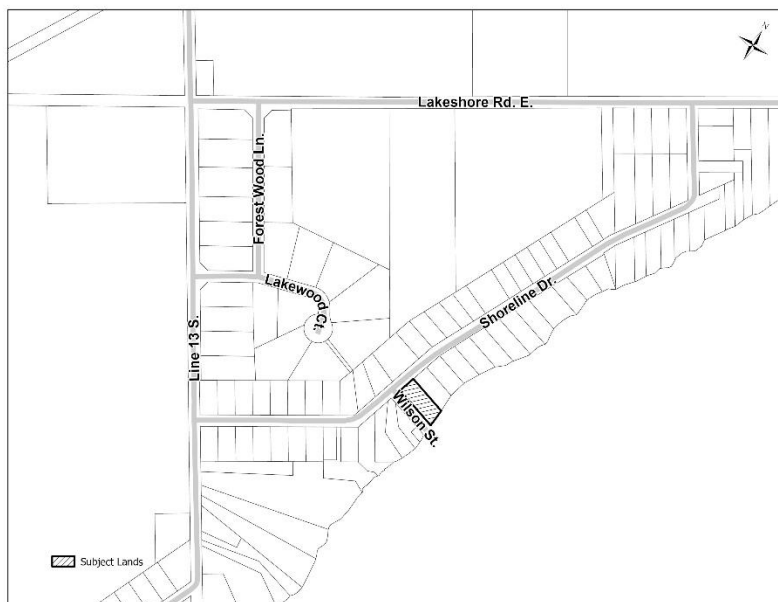

Interior Side Yard - 2.0 metres (6.5 feet)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1.08 metres (3.5 feet) for detached accessory building (shed)</li><li>• 0.9 metres (2.95 feet) for detached accessory building (canopy/deck)</li><li>• 0.9 metres (2.95 feet) for detached accessory building (gazebo/deck)</li></ul>
