



2023 Street Sweeping Program

Street sweeping helps to keep our storm drainage systems and ditches clear, improves storm water runoff quality, and improves air quality by limiting dust.

Each year the Street Sweeping Program starts in a different area of the Township so that streets in one area are not always swept last. This year, the program will start in Zone 1 on April 11, 2023, and then proceed to Zone 2, followed by Zones 3 and 4, with rural zones completed after the residential areas. Any sand raked from ditches out onto the shoulder of the road (in a row only), will be picked up by the crew as they pass by. This should be completed by April 11, 2023, for all Zone 1 residents.

As we cannot accurately schedule timing for zone completion, we ask that all residents in all other zones wishing to have sand picked up, have it placed on the shoulder by April 17, 2023. Please note the Township does not remove sand from ditches or driveways. Any sand that is placed on the shoulder of the road after the crew has been to your area will not be picked up.
