



COVID – 19 - Support Front Line Workers and Families By Doing Your Part

The Township of Oro-Medonte holds the health and safety of our residents, visitors and staff as a top priority. To assist with mitigating the spread of COVID-19, and to support social distancing recommendations, all Township facilities, including the Administration Centre are currently **closed to the public** until further notice. Township facilities remain staffed to provide core municipal services such as maintaining the Township’s water systems/services, and emergency services and response. Additionally, Business Continuity Plans are regularly reviewed.

The most important thing right now is to listen to the advice of our Doctors and Scientists in public health, being diligent about social distancing, ensuring proper and enhanced hand-washing, and limiting exposure among groups.
