Late last evening (October 7, 2021), the Township became aware of a precautionary boil water notice issued by Clearford Water Works Inc., (“Clearford”) for residents that are connected to the private Horseshoe Resort well supply; **also referred to as Zone 1. This precautionary boil water notice is not applicable to residents connected to the Horseshoe Highlands Municipal Drinking water system.**

Please note the Horseshoe Resort drinking water system is a privately operated system, not operated or managed by the Township.

Clearford is the licensed operator for the privately owned and operated Horseshoe Resort well supply. Township staff have been in contact with Clearford this morning, and were advised that Clearford will provide further communication to effected residents once the precautionary boil water notice has been lifted.

In accordance with the Ontario Drinking Water Regulation, Clearford will continue to work directly with the Ministry of the Environment Conservation and Parks on this matter.
