



THE TOWNSHIP OF ORO-MEDONTE REQUIRES DAY CAMP COUNSELLORS

The Township of Oro-Medonte is currently accepting applications for **Day Camp Counsellors** in our Community Services Department for the Summer Day Camp program.

Reporting to the Supervisor, Community Recreation and Special Events, and the Day Camp Coordinator, **Day Camp Counsellors** will provide leadership and supervision to the day camp participants. Both the Camp Coordinator and the Camp Counsellors will work with the Supervisor, Community Recreation and Special Events in the development of goals and objectives, daily/weekly activity plans and will fully participate in the daily operations of the camp program.

The successful candidates must be a minimum of 16 years of age and be able to work up to 40 hours per week, including some evenings/weekends (as required for special events and training). Knowledge of a wide variety of activities (sports, camp skills, drama, etc.) and a current First Aid Certification is a required. High Five PHCD and NLS Waterfront Lifeguard certification would be an asset.

Applicants must be currently enrolled as a student and returning to school in the fall. 2023 pay range is \$14.60 to \$17.60 per hour. Depending on age and position.

Staff training commences 1 to 2 weeks before camp starts and successful candidates must be able to attend all staff training.

- Summer Camp employment will commence the first week of July and continue to September 1, 2023.
