



The Township of Oro-Medonte requires a **CONTRACT - FACILITY LABOURER**

The Township of Oro-Medonte is currently seeking applicants for the 8 month position of “**Contract - Facility Labourer**”. Applicants will be considered in accordance with the terms outlined in the Collective Agreement. The working hours for this casual position will be a maximum of forty flexible hours per week, with scheduling to include days, evenings, weekends and holidays.

The Facility Labourer shall be responsible to perform a variety of custodial and general maintenance tasks in maintaining the cleanliness, appearance, sanitation and safety of buildings; ensuring the physical security of the facilities.

The applicant must possess a high school diploma and a one year related experience in custodial facility maintenance. The successful applicant must hold and maintain a valid Class “G” license shall be knowledgeable of the Ontario Health and Safety Act, WHMIS and be available to work flexible hours including days, evenings, weekends and holidays in a variety of environmental conditions. The position of Facility Labourer is a physically demanding position, requiring the ability to lift and carry up to 20 kilograms, climb ladders and stairs.

The successful candidate must meet the Province of Ontario’s definition of COVID-19 “fully vaccinated” or provide proof of a Human Rights Code exemption prior to commencement of their employment in accordance with the Township’s COVID-19 Vaccination Policy and be able to provide a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Screening.

This bargaining unit contract position and offers a salary commensurate with experience and education with a salary range of \$19.94 to \$24.82 per hour (2022 grid).
