The Township of Oro-Medonte, is recruiting for the position of Part-Time/Casual - Parks and Facility Operator for the Parks and Facilities Division of the Operations & Community Services Department. The working hours for this casual position will be a maximum of twenty-four flexible hours per week, with scheduling to include days, evenings, weekends and holidays.

The applicant must possess a high school diploma with experience and technical skills in ice making, resurfacing and refrigeration. Certification in First Aid/CPR is required. O.R.F.A. certificates in Ice Maintenance or Basic Refrigeration is an asset. The successful applicant must hold and maintain in good standing the appropriate motor vehicle (G) license classification as outlined by government regulations. The successful applicant shall be knowledgeable of the Ontario Health and Safety Act, WHMIS 2015.
