The successful candidates will be required to work 40 hours per week, in varied shifts. Having knowledge of traffic control, construction practices and mechanically inclined would be an asset.

To apply for this position, you must be a minimum of 18 years of age and hold a valid Class "G" driver's license. You must be currently enrolled as a student or recent graduate.

Employment will commence on approximately the first week of May and continue to Labour Day weekend. The Operations Labourer Student will be paid at a rate of \$18.50 per hour.
