



The Township of Oro-Medonte Requires a Seasonal Parks Labourer

The Township of Oro-Medonte is currently accepting applications for the position of Seasonal Parks Labourer in the Operations and Community Services Department.

Reporting to the Supervisor, Facilities and Parks, the Seasonal Parks Labourer shall provide general labour as required. Duties shall include assisting with the maintenance of the Township's facilities & parks, participating in the fall clean up of parks, playgrounds, ball diamonds and assist with the set-up of community ice rinks for the winter. The position of Seasonal Parks Labourer is a physically strenuous position, which includes but is not limited to shoveling, raking, sweeping, bending, lifting, carrying and the use equipment and supplies.

The successful candidate must be available to work flexible hours including evenings, weekends and statutory holidays during the months from September to December.

This four month bargaining unit contract position and offers a salary commensurate with experience and education with a salary range of \$19.94 to \$24.82 per hour (2022 grid).

The successful candidate must meet the Province of Ontario's definition of COVID-19 "fully vaccinated" or provide proof of a Human Rights Code exemption prior to commencement of their employment in accordance with the Township's COVID-19 Vaccination Policy, be able to provide a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Screening and hold and maintain a valid Class "G" license.
