



**The Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990
Notice of Passing of By-law 2019-128
Being a By-law to Amend Interim Control By-law 2018-109, as amended
in the Township of Oro-Medonte**

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Oro-Medonte passed By-law No. 2019-128 on the 11th day of December, 2019 under Section 38(2) of the Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990 c. P. 13.

By-Law No. 2019-128 applies to all lands within the Township of Oro-Medonte and therefore no Key Map is provided.

The Purpose and Effect of By-law 2019-128 is to amend By-law 2018-109, as amended, and extend the time period during which the by-law is in effect. By-law 2018-109, as amended, was originally adopted to permit the Township to undertake the necessary review of its land use planning policies pertaining to cannabis-related land uses and to prohibit the use of lands within the Township of Oro-Medonte for any cannabis-related land uses for a period of a one (1) year time period until December 12, 2019. By-law 2019-128 now extends that time period until June 4, 2020.

Section 38(2) of the Planning Act provides that the Council of the Township of Oro-Medonte has the authority to extend the period during which the by-law will be in effect to a total period not exceeding two years.

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal an interim control by-law to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf. A notice of appeal must be filed with the **Clerk of the Township of Oro-Medonte, not later than the 9th day of February, 2020**, a Notice of Appeal (including Appellant Form A1 found on the LPAT website) setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objection, with the appropriate fee of \$300.00 payable to the Minister of Finance and the appropriate appellant form.
