

## Notice of Open House and Public Meeting Official Plan Review for the Township of Oro-Medonte

Take notice that the Township of Oro-Medonte will hold a Virtual Open House on **August 31**st, **2022 at 5:30 p.m**.

Take notice that the Council of the Township of Oro-Medonte will hold a Virtual Public Meeting on **September 8**<sup>th</sup>, **2022 at 5:30 p.m**.

Take notice that the Township of Oro-Medonte has initiated the process to update its Official Plan pursuant to Sections 17 and 26 of the *Planning Act*, as amended. The proposed Official Plan applies to all lands within the Township of Oro-Medonte, as such no location map is provided.

An Official Plan is a municipal policy document required by the Province through the Planning Act that describes a municipality's land-use strategy for growth and development. An Official Plan contains policies and maps that are used to guide planning and development by identifying where land-uses can and should be located. It is also a way to ensure the future vision of the community is managed in a way that balances the social, economic and environmental interests of the Township.

The purpose and effect of the proposed Official Plan is to update the policies of the existing Official Plan to conform to and be consistent with Provincial policy, conform to the County of Simcoe Official Plan and to ensure that the Township's Official Plan responds to the community's needs.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the County of Simcoe to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Oro-Medonte before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Oro-Medonte before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Township of Oro-Medonte on the proposed Official Plan, you must make a written request.
