



Mayoral Decision MDE-2026-01

To give written notice to Members of Council and the Municipal Clerk to shorten the 10-day period where the Mayor can veto a budget amendment.

Whereas section 284.16 of Part VI.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the powers and duties of a municipality with respect to proposing and adopting a budget are assigned to the head of council of the municipality;

And Whereas section 7(7) of Ontario Regulation 530/22 provides that the head of council may in a year shorten the 10-day veto period referred to in subsection (6) for the year by providing to each member of Council and to the Clerk written document specifying a shorter period.

Now Therefore, I, Randy Greenlaw, Mayor of the Corporation of the Township of Oro-Medonte have decided as follows:

1. The Mayor will shorten the 10-day period to veto an amendment passed by Township Council to the mayor's proposed budget to seven (7) days after the expiry of the time period for Council to pass a resolution under subsection (3) of O. Reg. 530/22..
2. This Mayoral Decision provides written notice under subsection 284.16(4) of Part VI.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 and subsection 7(7) of O. Reg. 530/22.
3. This Mayoral Decision comes into effect on February 11, 2026.
