

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:

**CONTRACT: OCS RFQ26-001**

**ROAD REHABILITATION – Harbourwood Residential Development**



**May 25, 2026**

Beginning the week of June 1, 2026 the Township of Oro-Medonte will start road rehabilitation work in the Harbourwood Residential Development, as shown on the map below. Construction is expected to be completed by mid-July, weather permitting and subject to unforeseen circumstances. Oro-Medonte operations staff will also be completing minor ditching and culvert replacement in select areas.

## PLANNED CONSTRUCTION WORK

The scope of work under this contract includes cross-culvert replacement pulverizing the existing roadway, placement of granular material and 75 mm of asphalt. Granular shoulders will be restored, and all driveway entrances will be restored to their existing condition.

Before construction begins, underground utilities will be marked to help avoid potential issues during excavation.

## CONSTRUCTION IMPACT ON LOCAL RESIDENTS AND TRAFFIC

- Roads will remain open, and lane restrictions or detours will be put in place to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner. On certain occasions, road closures may be required for culvert installation. Residents will be notice before road closures.
- Access to private driveways will be impacted at times during road reconstruction and associated works.
- Waste collection schedules will not change during construction, although the typical pickup time may be earlier than normal. Waste materials should be placed on the curbside by 7 a.m. on your designated collection day.
- Special arrangements for mail delivery and school buses will be made if required.
- Property owners/residents are reminded that underground systems such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways and electrical conduits etc. may be within the Township-owned boulevard or property limits and may be impacted by the proposed construction work. The Township will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items that are within the Township-owned boulevard or property limits.

The Township appreciates your co-operation and patience as we work to complete the construction as quickly and efficiently as possible.
